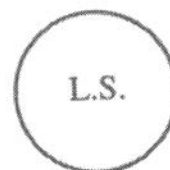

In section 6 of Statute I, insert new paragraph (11) and renumber existing paragraphs (11)-(12) as (12)-(13).

'(11) Unless otherwise specified, 'person' or 'member' means the resident holder of a teaching, research, or administrative post in the University or in any college, society, or Permanent Private Hall;'

SCHEDULE

UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD

STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON

TUESDAY, 9 October 2012

WHEREAS it is expedient to change the existing provisions governing the Douglas Byrne Marconi Fund, NOW THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD, in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, ENACTS, subject to the approval of Her Majesty in Council, AS FOLLOWS.

In the Schedule to the Statutes (Supplement (1) to *Gazette* No. 4633, 9 October 2002), after Part 76¹ insert the following new Part 77 (new text underlined, deleted text scored through):

'Part 77: § 51. Douglas Byrne Bussey Marconi Fund

¹ The number is subject to the approval of other legislative proposals and may therefore change.

77.1. A ~~Douglas-Byrne~~ Bussey Marconi Fund shall be created, into which shall be deposited a bequest for the establishment of the ~~Douglas-Byrne~~ Bussey Marconi Fellowship and lecture, together with any additional funds received for that purpose.

77.2. The Bodleian Library shall use the income but not the capital of the Fund for the support of the ~~Douglas-Byrne~~ Bussey Marconi Fellowship and lecture.

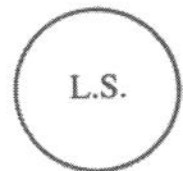
77.3. The administration of the Fund shall be the responsibility of the Curators of University Libraries, who ~~shall~~ may establish a Board of Management comprising: ~~delegate its authority to such bodies or persons as it deems appropriate.~~

- (1) ~~Bodley's Librarian or his or her nominee;~~
- (2) ~~the Director of the Museum of the History of Science or his or her nominee;~~
- (3) ~~the Professor of the History of Science in the University of Oxford.~~

77.4. ~~Regulations~~ Sections 77.1 and 77.3 above may be amended by ~~Council~~ Congregation.'

The Secretary of State for Justice, after giving ten days' notice of his intention to do so, has, under the Burial Act 1853 as amended, made representations to Her Majesty in Council that, subject to the exception below, burials should be discontinued in:-

- 1) Cathedral Churchyard and Ailcey Hill, Ripon Cathedral Parish with Littlethorpe, North Yorkshire (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto);
- 2) All Saints' Old Churchyard, East Hanningfield, Essex (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto);
- 3) St Giles' New Churchyard, Barrow, Shropshire (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto);
- 4) St Thomas a Becket's Churchyard, Pensford, Bristol (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto);
- 5) St James' Churchyard, West Tilbury, Thurrock, Essex (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto);
- 6) St John the Baptist's Churchyard, Stamford Bridge, East Riding of Yorkshire (as shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto).

The exceptions are that:-

- (a) in the places numbered 3, 5 and 6 above, in any existing earthen grave in the churchyard, the burial may be allowed of the body of any member of the family of the person or persons previously buried in that grave, but no part of the coffin containing the body shall be less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave;

- (b) in the places numbered 4, 5 and 6 above, in any vault or walled grave in the churchyard, burial may be allowed but every coffin in such vault or grave must be separately enclosed by stonework or brickwork properly cemented; and
- (c) in the places numbered 4, 5 and 6 above, in any grave space in which no interment has previously taken place, the burial may be allowed of any person for whom, or of any member of the family for which that grave space has been reserved and appropriated, with the exclusive right of burial there, but no part of the coffin containing the body shall be less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

Her Majesty in Council is pleased to give Notice of these representations and to order that they be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on 26th June 2013.

And Her Majesty is further pleased to direct that this Order should be published in the London Gazette, and that copies of it should be fixed on the doors of the Churches or Chapels of the above mentioned places, or displayed conspicuously inside them, for one month before 26th June 2013.
