AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SUSSEX

1. In the Definitions *delete* the definition "Officers of the University" and *substitute*:  
"Officers of the University" means the Chancellor, Pro-Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Pro-Vice-Chancellors, the Chief Operating Officer and the Secretary."
2. In section IV.1 *delete* paragraph (2) and *substitute*:  
"(2) The Deputy Vice Chancellor;".

AMENDMENT TO THE BYE-LAWS OF THE CONFEDERATION OF BRITISH INDUSTRY

**Delete** bye-law 17(a) and **substitute**:

- “17. (a) The President of the Confederation shall be elected at each Annual General Meeting and shall hold office until the next following Annual General Meeting. He/she shall then retire from office but shall be eligible for re-election at up to two further Annual General Meetings. For the avoidance of doubt, no individual may hold the office of President for more than three years (whether consecutive or otherwise).”.
