SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE LANDSCAPE INSTITUTE

1. *Delete* By-Law 18.3 and *substitute*:

“18.3 An Officer or Ordinary Member of Council elected in accordance with By-Law 18.1 shall be eligible for re-election in accordance with the following provisions:

18.3.1 any Officer or Ordinary Member of Council (except the President, President Elect or Immediate Past President) shall be eligible for re-election for one or more terms of up to two years, subject to a maximum overall term of six years; and

18.3.2 the President, President Elect and Immediate Past President may serve only the terms specified in By-Law 18.1.”.

2. In By-Laws 19.2 and 20.3 *delete* “four” and *substitute* “six”.

3. In By-Law 21:

- (i) in By-Law 21.1 *delete* “In this By-Law 17 a ‘year’ means” and *substitute* “In By-Laws 17-20 a ‘year’ means”;

(ii) **delete** By-Law 21.2;

(iii) **renumber** By-Law 21.3 as 21.2;

(iv) in By-law 21.2 as renumbered, at the end of the By-Law **insert**:

“A Member of Council who has reached the limit on their term of office may not stand for the same position on Council unless the person has a gap of at least one year out of office.”;

(v) **delete** By-Law 21.4.

4. **Delete** By-Law 22.3.
