*SCHEDULE*

AMENDMENTS TO THE BYELAWS OF THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTORS

1. **Renumber** Byelaws 13 to 40 as Byelaws 14 to 41.
2. **Insert** new Byelaw 13:

“13. Within the UK, the College shall have Regional Faculties as defined in the Regulations and the boundaries between the Regional Faculties and any other regulations concerning them shall be as defined in the Regulations. Unless otherwise prescribed in the Regulations, each member shall be deemed to belong to the Regional Faculty in which he practises as a chiropractor, works in connection with chiropractic, studies as a student or in the case of a Provisional Member undertakes postgraduate training. In the case of a member who has retired from clinical practice, he shall be deemed to belong to the Regional Faculty either in which he last practised or where he resides.”.

2. In renumbered Byelaw 33(i) **delete** “the Director of Regional Faculties” and **substitute** “two Membership Representatives”.
3. **Delete** renumbered Byelaw 35 and **substitute**:

“35. A person shall only be eligible to be elected an Officer if he is a Fellow of the College with the exception of the two Membership Representatives who may be Full Members or Fellows.”.

4. In renumbered Byelaw 36 *delete* “the Director of Regional Faculties”.
5. In renumbered Byelaw 38 *delete* “, the Director of Regional Faculties”.
6. *Delete* renumbered Byelaw 42 and *renumber* ByeLaws 43 to 80 as Byelaws 42 to 79.
