SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE SOCIETY FOR RADIOLOGICAL PROTECTION

1. In By-law 1:
 - a. after "In" where it occurs for the first time *insert* "the Charter";
 - b. *re-letter* sub-paragraphs (n) to (s) as sub-paragraphs (o) to (t); and
 - c. *insert* "(n) "RPC" means the Radiation Protection Council".
2. *Delete* By-law 2.
3. *Renumber* By-law 3 as By-law 2.
4. *Delete* By-law 4 and *substitute*:
 - "3. (a) The Corporate Members of the Society shall consist of:
 - (i) Honorary Fellows;
 - (ii) Fellows;
 - (iii) Members; and
 - (iv) Associate Members.

- (b) The Non-Corporate Members of the Society shall consist of:
 - (i) Affiliate Members; and
 - (ii) Such other categories as may be determined by the Council in Regulations.”.

5. **Renumber** By-laws 5 to 8 as By-laws 4 to 7.

6. In renumbered By-law 6 **delete** sub-paragraphs (i) to (iv) and **substitute**:

- “(a) Honorary Fellows shall be admitted at the discretion of Council in recognition of service to the Society, and entitled to use the post-nominal letters “FSRP”;
- (b) Fellows shall be admitted according to their qualifications and experience, and entitled to use post-nominal letters “FSRP”; and
- (c) Members shall be admitted according to their qualifications and experience, and entitled to use post-nominal letters “MSRP”.”

7. **Delete** heading “Titles”.

8. **Delete** By-laws 9 and 10.

9. **Renumber** By-law 11 as By-law 8.

10. After renumbered By-law 8 **insert**:

“The Registers of Practitioners

- 9. (a) The Council shall establish a committee, to be entitled the Radiation Protection Council (RPC), to implement and manage the Registers. The SRP Council shall grant the RPC such delegated authority to act on its behalf as shall be consistent with the requirement of reporting its proposals and actions to the Council given that the Society bears the ultimate responsibility for all matters concerned with its operation under its Charter.
- (b) Applicants to the Registers are required to be members of either the Society or of any of the organisations licensed by the RPC on behalf of the Society, and represented, on the RPC. Such licence shall allow the licensed organisation to admit its members to, and remove them from, the Registers subject to the oversight of the RPC. Licensed organisations may use, for the assessment of such applicants, any assessment processes as are approved by the RPC.
- (c) This registration shall be recognition, in the public interest, of the ability to practise in the field of radiation protection at the appropriate level, and of
