*SCHEDULE*

AMENDMENTS TO THE BYE LAWS OF THE CHARTERED ASSOCIATION OF BUSINESS SCHOOLS

1. In Bye Law 1.1:
  - (i) *delete* "four" and *substitute* "five";
  - (ii) after "Full Members," *insert* "Associate Members,".
2. In Bye Law 1.2:
  - (i) in the definition of "Full Member", after "other bodies" *insert* ", which may include branches of international institutions,";
  - (ii) after 1.2(c) *insert*:

“Associate Member” means institutions located in the United Kingdom, or branches of international institutions which have registered offices in the United Kingdom, which have a desire to become Full Members, but at that time do not meet the requirements for Full Membership.

Upon application to become an Associate Member, the Council will assess the current credentials of the organisation to identify an appropriate timeframe in

which it expects the applicant to meet the requirements of Full Membership. This may be up to five years. Applicants who then register as Associate Members will provide the Council with an annual report on their progress to meeting the criteria for Full Membership. If the Associate Member has not met the requirement for Full Membership by the end of the specified timeframe, the Council has the right to withdraw membership.”.

3. In Bye Law 21 *delete* “made in books”.
4. In Bye Law 22 *delete* “, in writing,”.
5. In Bye Law 24.1:
  - (i) after “except the first, at” *delete* “the” and *substitute* “a”;
  - (ii) after “expire” *delete* “and so far as practicable such Council meeting shall take place at least six months previous to the date when their appointment is to take effect.”;
  - (iii) *insert* “The Chair shall remain on the Council for the duration of their three year term of office, and shall not be required to stand for re-election to the Council during their tenure as Chair.”.
6. In Bye Law 24.2:
  - (i) after “except the first, at” *delete* “the” and *substitute* “a”;
  - (ii) after “expire” *delete* “and so far as practicable such Council meeting shall take place at least six months previous to the date when their appointment is to take effect”.
7. In Bye Law 24.3:
  - (i) after “except the first, at” *delete* “the” and *substitute* “a”;
  - (ii) after “expire” *delete* “and so far as practicable such Council meeting shall take place at least six months previous to the date when their appointment is to take effect”.
8. In Bye Law 25.2 after “other initiatives approved by the” *delete* “Board” and *substitute* “Council”.
9. In Bye Law 25.6 *delete* “terms not exceeding three years in total.” and *substitute* “three years and may be appointed for a further three years, not exceeding six years in total.”.
10. In Bye Law 25.12 after “Management Board” *insert* “in conjunction with the Chair and Chief Executive of the Chartered Association of Business Schools”.
