SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BATH

1. In Section 16, paragraph 16.1:
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a), **delete** “Pro-Chancellors, the” and “, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor”;
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (b) **delete** paragraph (ii);
 - (c) **renumber** paragraph (iii) as (ii);
 - (d) in renumbered paragraph (ii):
 - (1) **delete** “nine” and **substitute** with “ten”;
 - (2) after “in number,” **insert** “at least one of whom shall be an alumna/us of the University,”;
 - (e) in sub-paragraph (c)(i) **delete** “Four” and **substitute** with “Two”;
 - (f) **delete** sub-paragraph (c)(iii) and **substitute**:

“(iii) Two members of Staff who are not members of Academic Assembly of the University elected by the Staff who are not members of Academic Assembly of the University in accordance with the Ordinances.”.

(g) in sub-paragraph (d) after “Senate” *insert* “, normally President and Education Officer”.

2. In paragraph 16.3 *delete* sub-paragraph (a) and *substitute*:

“(a) An Appointed Member may serve for not more than a total of nine years save in exceptional cases and save for the Vice-Chancellor. As part of this maximum period, Officers (ie Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer) to serve a maximum of six years in those roles, save in exceptional cases. The Chair and Vice-Chair of Council shall be appointed in accordance with paragraph 1 and paragraph 2 of Section 17 of these Statutes.”.

3. In Section 28, paragraph 28.2:

(a) in sub-paragraph (i) after “any such body,” *insert* “save those of Council and its committees and joint committees with Senate,”;

(b) in sub-paragraph (iii)(a) after “Staff of the University;” *insert* “and”

(c) in sub-paragraph (iii)(b) *delete* “; and” and *insert* “.”;

(d) *delete* sub-paragraph (iii)(c).
