SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LEEDS

1. In Statute I, Section 1A:
 - (i) after “The Chair of Council and the Vice-Chancellor” **delete** “One representative of the Clothworkers' company of London”;
 - (ii) after “Four members of Faculties” **insert** “, and two members of the support staff,”;
 - (iii) after “to be” **delete** “elected from such constituencies and under such regulations as may be determined from time to time” and **substitute** “appointed”;
 - (iv) after “by the Council” **delete** “on the advice of the Senate”;
 - (v) **delete** “Two members of support staff to be elected from such constituencies and under such regulations as may be determined from time to time by the Council”;
 - (vi) **delete** “Two students to be chosen in such manner as may be determined from time to time by the Council” and **substitute** “The Union Affairs Officer and the Education Officer of Leeds University Union.”;
 - (vii) **delete** “Twelve” and **substitute** “Thirteen”;

- (viii) after “under ordinance)” *insert* “and one shall be a representative of the Clothworkers' Company”.
2. In Statute I, Section 1B:
- (i) *delete* “The representative of the Clothworkers' Company of London shall hold office for such period not exceeding three years at a time as the Company may from time to time determine.”;
 - (ii) after “Eligibility for re-appointment” *delete* “or re-election”;
 - (iii) after “or death among the appointed” *delete* “or elected”;
 - (iv) after “by the body which appointed” *delete* “or elected”.
3. In Statute II, Section 1A, after “To approve recommendations for appointment to the” *delete* “lay”.
