SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE BYE-LAWS OF THE MAGISTRATES' ASSOCIATION.

After Bye-law 85 *insert*:

“Officers

86. From time-to-time the Board of Trustees may designate membership of, or holding office in, certain organisations to be incompatible with being an officer of the Association. These individuals will be ineligible to serve as:

- (a) An Honorary Officer (Bye-law 1.f),
- (b) A member of Council (Bye-laws 31-39),
- (c) A member of the Board of Trustees (Bye-laws 48-49),
- (d) An officer of a recognised branch of the Association (Bye-laws 77-82),
- (e) A member (or chair) of the Standing Committees,
- (f) Co-opted members of the Board of Trustees, Council or the Standing Committees,
- (g) Such other Association role-holders as the Board of Trustees may from time-to-time designate.”.
