Burial Act
1855
(Variation)

Order varying an Order dated 20th March 1857 prohibiting further burials in All Saints Churchyard, Pontefract, West Yorkshire (referred to in the 1857 Order as "the old parish churchyard").

Petition

Order referring a Petition of Birkbeck College, University of London, praying for the grant of a Supplemental Charter, to a Committee of the Privy Council.
