*SCHEDULE*

SPECIAL STATUTE TO ALTER THE STATUTE OF NEWNHAM COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE ON 19 JUNE 2024 UNDER THE UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923, WHICH AMENDING STATUTE IS NOW SUBMITTED FOR THE APPROVAL OF HIS MAJESTY IN COUNCIL

We, the Principal and Fellows of Newnham College in the University of Cambridge, in pursuance of the power given to us by Section 7 of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923 and having obtained the approval of the Regent House on 31 January 2024, do hereby alter the Charter made under that Act in relation to our said College, subject to such changes as the Privy Council may require and as are agreed by us, in the manner following:

That in Charter Article 4 (Governing Body):

1. Delete paragraph (g) and substitute with:

(g) A number to be fixed by the Statutes and to be elected as prescribed by the Statutes from among the junior members of the College who are registered students as defined by the Statutes

So that Article 4(g) reads:

(g) A number to be fixed by the Statutes and to be elected as prescribed by the Statutes from among the junior members of the College who are registered students as defined by the Statutes

2. That in Charter Article 11 (Council)

Delete paragraph (c) and substitute with:

(c) A number to be prescribed by the Statutes and to be elected as prescribed by the Statutes from among the junior members of the College who are registered students as defined by the Statutes

So that Article 11 (c) reads:

(c) A number to be prescribed by the Statutes and to be elected as prescribed by the Statutes from among the junior members of the College who are registered students as defined by the Statutes

All the above changes were given their second reading at a meeting of the Governing Body on 29 February 2024.
