*SCHEDULE*

STATUTE TO ALTER AND AMEND THE STATUTES IN RELATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE, MADE UNDER THE UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923 (13 & 14 GEORGE V, CHAPTER 33), WHICH AMENDING STATUTE IS NOW SUBMITTED FOR THE APPROVAL OF HIS MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

We, the Chancellor, Masters, and Scholars of the University of Cambridge, in pursuance of the power given to us by Section 7 of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923 and having obtained the approval of the Regent House on 4 November 2024 and executed this Statute as a Deed on 5 November 2024, do hereby alter and amend the Statutes made under that Act in relation to our said University in manner following, that is to say:

That, with effect from the next election to the offices of Chancellor and High Steward, in Statute A I ([\*Statutes and Ordinances. 2023,p. 3\*](#)) Sections 1 and 9 be amended to read as follows and in Section 14 the words ‘High Steward,’ be deleted:

1. The Chancellor of the University shall be elected by the members of the Senate and shall hold office, in accordance with the laws and customs of the University, for one period of ten years from the date of election unless prior to the expiry of that period the Chancellor voluntarily resigns or the Senate otherwise determines by Grace in an individual case.

9. The High Steward shall be elected by the members of the Senate. The arrangements prescribed by Statute and Ordinance for the election and term of the Chancellor shall apply also to the election and term of the High Steward.
