AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE ROYAL PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY OF GREAT BRITAIN

- 1. In By-Law 9.4 *delete* "Notwithstanding the provisions of By-Law 11.3" and *substitute* "Save for the circumstances concerning the re-election of a President provided under By-Law 11.3".
- 2. **Delete** By-Law 11.3 and **substitute**:
  - "11.3 The President shall serve for a term of two years. A further term of two years may be served if once again elected by the Members. However, notwithstanding the provision of By-Law 9.4, in circumstances deemed by the Board of Trustees to be exceptional and with the majority support of the Members under provision of By Law 28.10(b) given at a General Meeting, a President who reaches six consecutive years on the Board of Trustees and the end of a second term in office as President be elected for a further term of two years as Trustee and President on completion of which they must retire their Trusteeship and the Presidency."
