Notwithstanding anything in the Order in Council made under the Burial Act 1853 on 11th December 1854, directing the discontinuance of burials in the Churchyard of St Mary's, Ottery St Mary, Devon, an exception be added in that the one further burial may be allowed of Lord Coleridge within the Churchyard, as specified in the Petition.
