A Petition of the National Citizen Service Trust was today read at the Board.

The Petition sets out among other things that the National Citizen Service Trust was incorporated by Royal Charter granted on 3rd May 2017 and sealed on 18th September 2017, and the Petition prays that His Majesty might be pleased to accept the surrender of the Charter.

The Petition encloses a Deed of Surrender which states that the affairs of the Trust have been wound up and the Trust is about to be dissolved, and with a view to such dissolution the Trust has asked His Majesty to sanction the surrender of their Charter in accordance with the provisions of Article 17 thereof.

Accordingly, His Majesty, having taken the Petition and Deed into consideration, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to sanction and accept the surrender of the Charter of the National Citizen Service Trust in accordance with the Deed of Surrender; and to declare that the Charter is revoked and annulled with effect from 11.59pm on 11th July 2025: Provided always that this revocation and annulment shall not prejudice, abridge or affect any existing claim of any party or parties against the Trust or any member or members of it.
