The following report from the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Jersey and Guernsey was today read at the Board:

“In accordance with the Royal Assent to Legislation and Petitions (Bailiwick of Jersey) Order 2022 the Committee have considered a letter from the Greffier of the States of Jersey transmitting an Act passed on 9th July 2025 entitled the Criminal Justice (Young Offenders) (Jersey) Amendment Law 2025:

The Committee have considered the Act and have agreed to report that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to approve and ratify it.”

His Majesty, having taken the report into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve and ratify the Act (a copy of which is annexed to this Order) and to order that it, together with this Order, shall be entered on the Register of the Island of Jersey and observed accordingly. His Majesty's Officers in the Island, and all others whom it may concern, are therefore to take notice of His Majesty's Order and to proceed accordingly.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE (YOUNG OFFENDERS) (JERSEY) AMENDMENT LAW 202-

A **LAW** to amend the Schedule to the [Criminal Justice \(Young Offenders\) \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#).

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of His Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

1 [Criminal Justice \(Young Offenders\) \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#) amended

This Law amends the [Criminal Justice \(Young Offenders\) \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#).

2 Schedule (constitution and procedures of Youth Court) amended

In the Schedule –

- (a) in paragraph 1 (appointment of members of Youth Court) –
 - (i) in sub-paragraph (1), for “chairman” there is substituted “chair”;
 - (ii) in sub-paragraph (4), for “shall retire on the member’s 60th birthday” there is substituted “must retire on or before their 70th birthday”;
- (b) in paragraph 2 (proceedings) –
 - (i) in sub-paragraph (1), in both places it occurs, for “chairman” there is substituted “chair”;
 - (ii) in sub-paragraph (4), for “chairman” there is substituted “chair”;
- (c) in paragraph 3 (decisions of Youth Court) –
 - (i) in sub-paragraph (1), in both places it occurs, for “chairman” there is substituted “chair”;
 - (ii) in sub-paragraphs (2) and (3), in each place it occurs, for “chairman” there is substituted “chair”.

3 Citation and commencement

This Law may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Young Offenders) (Jersey) Amendment Law 202- and comes into force 7 days after it is registered.
