The Statute has been submitted to His Majesty in Council, and the provisions of the Act relating to publication in the London Gazette and laying before both Houses of Parliament have been complied with.

No petition or address has been presented against the Statute.

Now, therefore, His Majesty, having taken the Statute into consideration, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve it.

STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON

TUESDAY, 20 May 2025

WHEREAS it is expedient to change the existing provisions governing the Samir Shamma Associate Professor in Islamic Numismatics, Epigraphy and Material Culture, NOW THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD, in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, ENACTS, subject to the approval of His Majesty in Council, AS FOLLOWS.

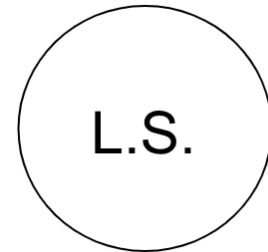
In the Schedule to the University Statutes, amend §72.4-72.5 of Part 72 §72.4-72.5 as follows (new text underlined, deleted text struck through):

‘72.4. (1) The Associate Professor shall lecture, give instruction and carry out research in Islamic Numismatics, Epigraphy and Material Culture under the direction of the Board of the Faculty of ~~Oriental Studies~~ Asian and Middle Eastern Studies.

(2) The Associate Professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of Associate Professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to this post.

72.5. The administration of the Fund, and the application of its income, shall be the responsibility of the Board of the Faculty of ~~Oriental Studies~~ Asian and Middle Eastern Studies (“the Board of Management”).’
