SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE BYE-LAWS OF THE CHARTERED INSTITUTION OF CIVIL ENGINEERING SURVEYORS

1. In Bye-laws 1.1, 15, 16, 18(c), 20 and 24 **delete** "him" and **substitute** "them" wherever it occurs.
2. **Delete** Bye-law 1.2 and **substitute**:

"1.2 Words importing a particular gender include all genders. Words in the singular include the plural and words in the plural include the singular."
3. In Bye-laws 11, 27 and 51(c) **delete** "he has" and **substitute** "they have" wherever it occurs.
4. In Bye-laws 11, 15, 18(d), 20, 27, 36, 42, 47, 48, 50 and 51 **delete** "his" and **substitute** "their" wherever it occurs.
5. In Bye-laws 11, 27 and 51(c) **delete** "he has" and **substitute** "they have" wherever it occurs.
6. In Bye-laws 18(c), 36, 47, 48 and 51 **delete** "he" and **substitute** "they" wherever it occurs.

7. In Bye-laws 22, 31, 51 and 52 *delete* “he is” and *substitute* “they are” wherever it occurs.
8. In Bye-law 27 *delete* “chair man” and *substitute* “chair”.
9. In Bye-law 29(c) *delete* “chair manship” and *substitute* “chair,”.
10. In Bye-law 43 *delete* “chair man at” and *substitute* “chair of”.
11. In Bye-law 48 *delete* “ceases” and *substitute* “cease”.
12. In Bye-law 51:
 - (i) in (d) *delete* “fails” and *substitute* “fail”;
 - (ii) in (f) *delete* “becomes” and *substitute* “become”;
 - (iii) in (h) *delete* “resigns” and *substitute* “resign”.
13. In Bye-law 62 *delete* “he was” and *substitute* “they was”.
14. In Bye-law 64 *delete* “chairman” and *substitute* “chair” wherever it occurs.
